

Welcome to Indianapolis, Indiana

We are glad to have you as our guests. You will receive food, shelter, clean water and medical care soon.

Here is what will be happening in the next few hours.

1. **Arrive** at Indianapolis International Airport. You will be registered into our system, so that we can account for you and your family. You will be given a wristband for admission onto the bus for transportation to the Indiana State Fairgrounds.



2. **Health Screening**
You will get a health screening to make sure you are OK.



*Tell the doctor if you have any medical conditions such as diabetes, sickle cell, asthma, alcoholism, AIDS/HIV, epilepsy, high blood pressure, are pregnant or any other problems/conditions.

*Tell the doctor if you take any medications and if you have missed these in the last week.

* Do you have any allergies?

3. **The Indiana State Fairgrounds**
You will be taken by bus to the Indiana State Fairgrounds. It is located 15 miles east of the Indianapolis International Airport (approx. 30 minute ride). You will be provided with shelter, water, food, clothing, medical care, and access to a phone.

Indianapolis, Indiana

Location

Indiana is located in the midwest part of the United States. Indianapolis is the capital, and is in the center of the state.

Population

There are more than 6 million people in Indiana. The Indianapolis area has approximately 1.2 million people. There are approximately 10 urban centers in Indiana, and the rest of the state is rural. Population centers include Lake County (including Gary, in northwest corner of the state, by Chicago, Illinois), Fort Wayne (northeast), South Bend (north central), Evansville (southwest corner), and Bloomington (southwest central).

Time Zone

Indianapolis and most of Indiana is on Eastern Standard Time, which means we don't change to daylight savings time. We are currently on Central Time (same as Chicago), but on the first weekend in October, the rest of the country changes and we will be on Eastern Time (same as New York). The other cities in Indiana, such as Evansville and Gary, change time, so be sure to ask if you go there!

Average Weather

The high temperature in Indianapolis averages 63 degrees in September and 53 degrees in October.

Religion

All religions are represented in the State of Indiana.

Landscape

Indianapolis is hilly in the southern half of the state and flat in the northern half.
