- 1) Changing how the county tests its fire pagers.
 - o Vote passed to change the nightly pager test to Sunday night only
- 2) Setting a date as to when the county would have all radios reprogrammed to utilize the pl on old fire and the addition of the new fire ground channels.
 - o Vote passed to have all radios reprogrammed by June 1st.
- 3) The next round of 800 mHz radios
- 4) A new training program that has been purchased by the Henry County Emergency Management Agency and is being provided to all Henry County fire Dept.s.
- 5) Rip and Run sheets
- 6) The possibility of utilizing Spillman (the counties dispatch software) for incident and NIFRS reporting. (Jeff Murry to address this issue with Spillman)
- 7) The new version of the conty CEMP that is being worked on
